



Transportation Technologist

The Role

Customer service oriented, you will be responsible for ensuring municipal traffic controls are in place for existing infrastructure to facilitate safe and efficient vehicular movement. You will carry out analyses and studies concerning the effectiveness of existing municipal traffic controls, analyze the merit and appropriateness of traffic calming, and implement traffic calming measures where required. You will develop and coordinate a data collection program and utilize equipment to collect in-field transportation data. You will use AutoCAD to undertake designs of Active Transportation facilities and attend public information centres as appropriate. You will assist in the review of planning applications and undertake inspections. While implementing and coordinating the radar-speed board program, you will review and process traffic-related complaints through direct response, provide instructions to other departments and/or agencies as well as assisting to prepare reports and recommendations to Council for their direction and/or bylaw endorsement.

Your Civil Engineering Technologist diploma is complemented by a C.E.T. designation, a minimum of five years of relevant experience, strong communication (verbal and written) skills, and a valid Class G driver's licence. If hired, you will be required to supply a criminal reference check that is satisfactory to the Town of Ajax.
