This position will involve operating an aerial bucket truck, and responding to trouble calls during normal business hours and while on stand-by.

Your qualifications as a Traffic Signal Specialist must include:

- Possession of a valid Certificate of Qualification as a Construction and Maintenance Electrician under the Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 309A and/or 442.
- Possession of a Class "G" driver's licence and a point-free driving record and/or a record found to be satisfactory to the City of Hamilton. Applicants with a "DZ" driver's licence will be preferred. All applicants must be capable of obtaining and maintaining a "DZ" licence in order to continue employment in this position. Said licence must be obtained within 90 calendar days of hire.
- Ability to work in all outdoor environments and seasons.
- Ability to climb into, and out of, aerial buckets with a maximum lifting capacity of 300 lbs and operate from an aerial device at heights ranging from 3 to 10 metres.
- Experience installing, maintaining, troubleshooting and repairing analog and digital equipment as well as installing and maintaining 120 VAC field wiring and connections.
- Previous experience with the installation and maintenance of electronic traffic control equipment as well as Certification with IMSA considered assets.
