- March 20, 2019 first ever province wide Crossing Guard Appreciation Day
- Celebrated by more than 20 municipalities across the province

Why an Appreciation Day?

- Gap in recognition
- Lack of consistency across municipalities
 - Multiple dates, time of year, various practices
- Road safety messaging and education
 - Increased road danger, pedestrian exposure
- Stewardship and investment in the community
 - Community presence and human connection

What we Looked to Achieve

- Newly celebrated Crossing Guard Appreciation Day looked to achieve the following:
 - Bring recognition to the crossing guard program and what it entails
 - Showcase the hard work crossing guards do on a daily basis regardless of weather or working conditions
 - Bring awareness to the safety of pedestrians within the crosswalks and intersections
 - Build Community partnerships
 - Help make crossing guards feel proud of the work they do on a daily basis.

The Prep

- To make Crossing Guard Appreciation Day a successful event, municipalities undertook the following:
 - Program committee created a communication plan to guide the outreach of the program
 - Submitted media release(s) to the public with graphics and details to showcase the event
 - Participated in social media promotion municipalities, members of council and partner organizations
 - Provided packages to schools to participate in acknowledging and recognizing crossing guards throughout the municipality

- COME TO A COMPLETE STOP once a Crossing Guard raises their stop sign

 park only in designated areas.






The Day


- Municipalities worked with various stakeholders and partners to share in the celebration of the day. Participation spanned across a number of groups:


