JOB SUMMARY

Collects and analyses traffic data related to road safety and road use management. Investigates complaints and inquiries received from the public and other agencies, pertaining to traffic conditions and makes recommendations on potential road safety improvements. Prepares work orders for the installation of signs and pavement markings related to road safety. Maintains the collision and traffic database. Prepares reports and by-law amendments regarding road safety modifications for Committee and Council approval, ensuring alignment with the Vision Zero objectives.
