Purpose:

Reporting to the Supervisor of Transportation Planning, the Project Manager – Mobility Planning is a new role which is intended to bring a fresh perspective to the planning of the Region's transportation network by applying a multi-modal lens. This position will lead the Transportation Master Plan update and associated development charges study, Municipal Class Environmental Assessment studies, and transit and active transportation related initiatives.

Preferred Background:

The successful applicant must possess post-secondary education in Engineering or applied sciences field, a Certified Engineering Technologist (C.E.T.) designation is required, a Professional Engineers Ontario (P.Eng.) designation is preferred, and a minimum of five (5) years of directly related experience in the planning of multi-modal transportation networks, including transit, along with proven knowledge of the principles and practices of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process. Formal project management training through an accredited facility (such as those recognized by the Project Management Institute) with demonstrated experience in delivering projects on time and on budget. Excellent oral/written communication and negotiation skills are required to interface with various stakeholders including external agencies, members of council, regional and local staff, consultants, and the general public. Knowledge of computer software including familiarity with transportation modelling (EMME, GTAv4) would be an asset. An equivalent combination of education and experience will be considered.

Working Conditions:

The successful incumbent must supply their own transportation and will be required to provide a copy of their driver's licence by first day of employment.

Duties:

- Undertake mobility related studies and initiatives, including the Transportation Master Plan update, utilizing a multi-modal approach and leading projects from the chartering stage through to completion.
- Provide a mobility perspective to the review of and feedback on various planning studies and processes.

- Represent the Region's interests and act as liaison with various technical committees, cultivating strong and collaborative relationships with staff of appropriate provincial ministries/agencies, adjacent municipalities and local municipal partners within Halton Region.
- Assist with the preparation of staff reports and recommendations to Regional Council on all matters dealing with multi-modal mobility.
- Participate in the development of and execution of assignments as per the Transportation Planning team's annual work plan.
- Advocating for the Region's interests as part of Technical Advisory Committees for transit and mobility initiatives undertaken by other agencies.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
