Mississauga's First TMP: A Commitment to Sustainability Using an Innovative Approach

By using an innovative approach to deliver a sustainable future, Mississauga's first Transportation Master Plan, endorsed by Council in May 2019, is unique in Canada. At the plan's core is a commitment to sustainability: The City will ensure that everyone and everything will have the freedom to move safely, easily and efficiently to anywhere at any time. Beyond environmental impacts, auto-reliance is also socially and economically unsustainable: traffic is increasing making car travel inefficient, our population has more youth and seniors than ever before who are often unable to drive, and car costs are onerous. Put simply, Mississauga's auto-reliant transportation system makes reaching jobs, friends, and shops safely and efficiently difficult for many. To tackle auto-reliance, the MTMP challenges established expectations of TMPs. Instead of starting with a traffic forecasting study, the MTMP was delivered through a community visioning study grounded in robust technical analysis.
