Reporting to the Supervisor of Traffic Services, the Streetlight Linesman will work as part of a team responsible for the installation, repair and maintenance of the street lighting systems and subsystems.

Duties included but are not limited to are:

- Work safely with no electrical contact incidents or personal injuries
- Perform replacement, repair and maintenance on street light equipment, hardware, and infrastructure as required
- Maintain and repair electrical distribution, including conduits, cables, wires, circuit breakers, for street lighting
- Respond to street lighting malfunctions, performing diagnostics and troubleshooting to identify faults and make necessary repairs
- Maintain accurate records of daily activities and be fluent in the use of computers
- Occasionally erect and maintain steel, wood or concrete poles and guy wires
- Able to lift, push, pull and carry up to 75 pounds
- Oversee and inspect the work of contractors to ensure adherence to specification
- Operate an aerial truck work at a height of up to 15m meters
- Work outdoors in all weather conditions
- Respond to on-call duties when required

QUALIFICATIONS

- Applicants must have successfully completed Grade 12 or the equivalent plus a three year post-secondary education in Electrical Engineering Technology
- Completion of an approved apprenticeship program (such as a major power utility); or an IBEW union card indicating the classification of Journeyman Line worker; or a letter from a previous employer (on company letterhead) clearly stating completion of all the OSHA 1910.269 training requirements for a lineman; or military training supported by DD214 or DD2586 documentation
- Previous experience in the street light industry would be an asset
- A valid DZ Ontario driver's license in good standing is required
- IMSA Street lighting Level 1 and Level 2 certification will be an asset
- Proficient in understanding and reading blueprints
- Strong communication, leadership, team work and customer service skills
